



Erasmus+ SMT (Traineeship) Mobility at l'Université Grenoble Alpes (UGA) -Faculty of Medicine 2024-2025

What is offered at UGA for students on Erasmus+ SMT (Traineeship) mobility?

Clinical rotations of 4 weeks full-time in one or more of the following specialties, organized by "poles":

	Hospital Unit
Pole S1 : Macro and microcirculation – Gas Exchanges	Cardiology, Heart Surgery, Vascular Surgery, Pulmonology, Thoracic Surgery, ENT (Ear-Nose- Throat), Plastic and Maxillofacial Surgery, Radiology
Pole S2 : Human body frame – System of conduction, relationship and integration	Rheumatology, Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Orthopedics/Traumatology, Hand and Burns Surgery, Ophthalmology, Neurology, Neurosurgery, Adult Psychiatry, Child Psychiatry
Pole S3 : Cell exchanges – Intracellular metabolism – Nutrition – Pregnancy to birth – Hormones – Nephrotic and urological syndromes	Gynecology, Obstetrics, Medically Assisted Procreation, Diabetology Nutrition, Endocrinology, Nephrology, Urology, Gastroenterology and Hepatology, Digestive Surgery and Emergency
Pole T4 : Intercellular relationship – Immunity – Cancerology – Internal medicine - Geriatrics	Internal Medicine, Dermatology, Geriatrics, Forensic Medicine, Clinical Haemotology, Oncology, Infectious Diseases
Pole T5 : Development pathology - Emergencies	Multipurpose Pediatrics, Pediatric Emergency, Neonatology, Pediatric Surgery, Adult Emergency, Anaesthesia & Post Surgery, Intensive Care Unit

Clinical rotations of 4 weeks are worth 6 ECTS. Students can receive a transcript of records at the end of their mobility period if required by their home university.

All clinical rotations are available in both semester 1 (September – January) and semester 2 (February - June). (Please note that we do not propose clinical rotations in July and August.)

Students wishing to come on Erasmus+ SMT (Traineeship) mobility must be nominated by their home university during the same nomination period as Erasmus+ SMS (Studies) students. (See procedure on following page.)

E Students must indicate their priority choices and alternative choices for clinical rotations during the application process. UGA does its best to place students in hospital units of their top choice, but substitutions are often necessary due to a lack of spaces available for Erasmus students in the majority of units. Clinical rotations are organized by the International Relations Office at UGA following the student's acceptance. Students must not contact hospital units directly in order to ask to carry out a placement.



Selected students will be given the option of accommodation in a student residence. Students must indicate their wish for student housing during the application process and will receive housing assignments in the months following.



Erasmus+ students are offered 20 hours of free French (FLE) classes worth 3 ECTS during their mobility, either in the form of an intensive week (end of August) or a weekly evening class (September – December or January – April).





Procedure for Erasmus+ SMT (Traineeship) Mobility at l'Université Grenoble Alpes – Faculty of Medicine 2024-2025

Step ①: Nomination by the sending university

All students wishing to come to UGA on SMT mobility must nominated by their home university during the following nomination periods:

- For mobility in the 1st semester / full year : from March 15th to April 30th, 2024
- For mobility in the 2nd semester only : from August 30th to September 30th, 2024

Please note that nominations received outside of the specified deadlines will not be accepted.

Step (2): Online application by the student

Students will be contacted by the International Relations Office at the Faculty of Medicine following their nomination. They will be sent a link to the online application platform and other relevant information regarding the organization of their mobility at UGA and specifics for the Faculty of Medicine. Students must then complete their online application by the deadline.

Online application periods:

- From March 15th to May 30th, 2024 (for 1st semester and full year students)
- From September 15th to October 18th, 2024 (for 2nd semester students)

Step ③: Acceptance and pre-arrival procedures

Students will receive an email from the International Relations Coordinator at UGA once their application has been accepted. This email will include the official acceptance letter to UGA (in French and in English) as well as a mandatory health form to be completed and sent back by a specified date.

Step ④: Clinical rotation confirmation by the IRO at UGA and next steps

The students will receive confirmation from the Incoming Students Coordinator at UGA of the hospital units in which they will carry out their clinical rotations. They can then complete and validate their Learning Agreements by their home university and have them signed by UGA. Students will receive further information regarding the specifics of each rotation (contact information, 1st day arrival information, hospital map, etc.) by email prior to their arrival and the beginning of their rotations.
