Application Deadline	 1st SEMESTER and FULL YEAR: April 1st-June 1st 2nd SEMESTER: September 15th - November 15th. -September, 1-30: Traineeships in Dentistry, Nursing, Physiotherapy & Podiatry *For traineeships in Medicine the application must be done from April 1st to June 1st, either they are for the 1st or the 2nd Semester. **All Learning Agreement (LA), Online Learning Agreement (OLA) or Study Agreement for SICUE must be submitted by the Faculty of Medicine by June, 1st, regardless of whether they are for the first or second semester.
